Re: AMA support for LD 85

Dear Senator Chipman and Representative Tipping:

On behalf of the American Medical Association (AMA) and our physician and medical student members, I am writing to express our support for Legislative Document 85 (L.D. 85), a bill which would create a sales tax exemption and income tax deduction for the purchase of firearm safety devices.

With more than 38,000 deaths each year, gun violence is a major public health crisis. Recent studies have shown that deaths by firearms are at their highest levels in decades and have become the second leading cause of death for children. Tragically, these deaths are entirely preventable. We must all work together to find common-sense approaches to reduce firearm-related injuries and deaths in our communities.

Fortunately, gun safety is one area in which we can all agree. Safe storage measures, such as those that are incentivized by L.D. 85, are an important piece of a comprehensive public health approach to preventing gun injuries and deaths. The AMA has long-standing policy on firearm safety and injury prevention, including extensive policy encouraging the use of safety devices such as gun locks, trigger locks, locked gun cabinets, drop safety pins and loading indicators. We believe this legislation will help save lives.
